Top Ten Details / LONDON

- 1 Centre Dome of St. Paul's Cathedral:** glory and majesty swirl within the mother-church of the Diocese of London with paintings, and frescoes. [*Ludgate Hill - Tube: St. Paul's*]
- 2 The Crown Jewels in the Tower of London:** resplendent symbols of power and wealth. [*Tower Hill - Tube: Tower Hill*]
- 3 The ceiling of Banqueting House:** in the painting by Rubens an exuberant celebration and commemoration of King James I. [*Whitehall - Tube: Charing Cross*]
- 4 The Gherkin:** the steel and glass building by Sir Norman Foster mirrors the city's soul. [*30 St. Mary Axe - Tube: Liverpool St.*]
- 5 Central Lobby of the Houses of Parliament:** magnificent mosaics represent the four nationalities of the U.K. along with their patron saints. [*Parliament Square - Tube: Westminster*]
- 6 Albert Memorial:** the princely monument to Queen Victoria's consort in high Victorian style. [*Kensington Gardens - Tube: South Kensington*]
- 7 Arab Hall, Leighton House:** elaborate windows, colorful tiles and ornate woodwork embody the symbolism of a complex culture. [*12 Holland Park Road - Tube: Holland Park*]
- 8 Wellington Arch:** from the platform atop the triumphal arch the views of London are magnificent. [*Duke of Wellington Place at Hyde Park Corner - Tube: Hyde Park Corner*]
- 9 Westminster Abbey:** pomp and circumstance in the church where royal weddings, and coronations have taken place since 1066. [*Broad Sanctuary - Tube: Westminster*]
- 10 The Devonshire Hunting Tapestries at the Victoria & Albert Museum.** [*Cromwell Road - Tube: South Kensington*]
