- 1 Woolworth Building:** the “Cathedral of Commerce” [233 Broadway, Park Place/Barclay St. - Subway: City Hall (N, R trains)]
- 2 National Museum of the American Indian.** [1 Bowling Green, State/Whitehall Streets - Subway: Bowling Green (4, 5 trains)]
- 3 New York Public Library & Rose Reading Room:** the grande dame of Beaux-Arts design in the city that never sleeps. [Fifth Avenue & 42nd Street - Subway: Fifth Avenue (7 train)]
- 4 Grand Central Terminal:** a ceiling reflecting the ambitions of the first American tycoons. [42nd Street & Park Avenue - Subway: Grand Central (4, 5, 6, 7, S trains)]
- 5 Park Avenue Armory:** a superb repository of 19th-century Gilded Age interiors. [640 Park Ave., 66th/67th Sts. - Subway: E. 68 St. (6 train)]
- 6 Metropolitan Museum:** inside one of the world's greatest collections of art. [Fifth Avenue & 84th Street - Subway: 86th Street (4, 5, 6 trains)]
- 7 Cathedral of St. John the Divine:** saints and sinners protect a still unfinished 1892 cathedral. [1047 Amsterdam Ave. at 112th St. - Subway: 110th Street/Cathedral Parkway (1, 9, B, C trains)]
- 8 Grace Church:** Gothic Revival in the heart of the hip East Village. [802 Broadway at E. 10th St. - Subway: 8th Street (N, R train)]
- 9 The Pythian:** high drama from an astounding array of colorful Art-Deco sphinxes, and pharaohs. [135 W. 70th Street, Broadway/Columbus Ave. - Subway: 72nd Street (1, 2, 3, 9 trains)]
- 10 Top of the Rock:** 70 floors above the city, the views of New York are endless. [30 Rockefeller Plaza - Subway: 47-50 Streets (B, D, F, V trains)]
