Top Ten Details / PARIS

- 1 A stroll among the tombs in the Père Lachaise cemetery:** from Chopin to Jim Morrison, and Oscar Wilde. [*Metroline 2, Philippe Auguste stop*]
- 2 Stories in light, in the stained-glass windows of the Sainte Chapelle.** [*Metroline 4, Cité stop*]
- 3 Vendôme Column:** a “Roman” column in Paris, celebrating the last emperor. [*Metroline Madeleine, Tuilerie, Opéra*]
- 4 Arab World Institute:** from the facade, “photographing” Arab culture. [*Metroline Jussien, Cardinal-Lemoine*]
- 5 The Maria de Medici cycle by Rubens, at the Louvre:** art mirroring myth, history, and politics. [*Metroline 1, Palais Royal/ Musée du Louvre stop*]
- 6 The exterior of the Cathedral of Notre Dame:** stories of saints and demons’ likenesses in stone. [*Metroline 4, Cité stop*]
- 7 The exterior of the Opéra Garnier and the dome of the center hall, with Chagall’s fresco.** An immense masterpiece of architecture, sculpture, and painting. [*Metroline Opéra*]
- 8 The Lady and the Unicorn and the cycle of the Five Senses:** a unicorn hunt in precious weaves. [*Musée National du Moyen Age - Place du Painlevé*]
- 9 Centre George Pompidou:** inside-out architecture, with the structures and service ducts on the exterior, in plain view, and colorful, to allow people and ideas to circulate freely. [*Metroline, Rambuteau, Hotel de la Ville stop*]
- 10 Magasins Printemps:** shopping in the shade of Rinet’s great dome. [*Boulevard Haussmann*]
